Peglerae ER24 to be used after-hours for life-threatening medical emergencies only!



It has come to our **attention**, that in some instances, our members use the Peglerae Emergency Room (ER24) in Rustenburg for **non-life-threatening emergencies** during **normal** working hours.

We want to **remind** you that if you need medical assistance during **normal** working hours, you should go to the **Platinum Health Medical Centre (PHMC)** in Rustenburg where we have an **Emergency Room**. This includes the management of **emergencies** such as the **suturing of wounds**, **dressings**, **consultations**, **medication and intravenous (IV) treatment**, X-rays, sonar, electrocardiograms (ECG's) and blood tests.

PHMC is **situated** on the corner of Beyers Naude Drive and Heystek Street in Rustenburg.

The **normal** working hours for PHMC is as follows:

Mondays to Fridays	08:00 – 18:00
Saturdays	08:00 - 14:00

Sundays 08:00 – 12:00

You may only use Peglerae ER24 after-hours if you have a life-threatening medical emergency!
